

# Girl's Soccer By-Laws

- Athletic Director in-charge:** Chippewa Falls
- Annual Meeting Date:** Monday evening following the last conference game or BRC tournament.
- Game Start Time:** Varsity 5:00pm  
Back to back games that are scheduled shall have times of 5:00 and 7:00
- JV 5:00pm  
Back to back games that are scheduled shall have times of 5:00 and 7:00
- Warm Up Time:** Varsity Set clock at 20 minutes  
JV Five minutes before game, players to bench, follow by National Anthem and introductions of starters for both teams

- Uniforms:** Home team shall wear white colored jersey
- Equipment:** The National Federation rules and WIAA rules will be used for all games and equipment selection.
- Referees and Scorers:** There will be three officials for varsity and two for junior varsity games.
- Media/Results:** The host school shall be responsible for reporting the results to the media and both schools to the BRC statistician following the game.
- Conference Schedule:** The conference schedule will consist of a double round robin schedule. Postponed games will be rescheduled by mutual consent.
- Conference Championship:** The conference champion will be determined according to the point total from dual conference competition. Teams will be awarded three (3) points for a victory and one (1) point for a tie.
- All-Conference Release Date:** The All-Conference team will be released after all BRC teams have been eliminated from the WIAA tournament or after the Sectional Finals, whichever happens first.
- All-Conference Selection:** The coaches will nominate players from their team that they feel are worthy of being named all conference. The players that they nominate should be one of the top 22 players in the BRC. Coaches will use the nomination ballot provided by the AD in

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charge of soccer. Nominations are due back to the AD by the Tuesday of the last week of the regular season. The AD in charge will provide a list of nominations along with the information form provided by each school to all coaches via fax or email prior to the All-Conference meeting. Using the list of nominations and the information from, coaches will vote for a first and second all conference team. The nomination list will have all the nominated athletes listed by name and school only. When voting, each coach will vote for the players they feel deserve to be named to the first team by using numbers 1-10 (#1 as their top choice) for the field players and #1 for their choice of first team goalkeeper. For the second team coaches will use numbers 11-20 (#11 as the top second team player) and #2 for the second team goalkeeper. A #1 ranking shall equal 20 points, #2 ranking shall equal 19 points, #3 ranking shall equal 18 points etc. down to #20 ranking equals 1 point. Coaches may not vote for players from their own team. The next 11 players that receive the highest number of votes will be named to the honorable mention team. Each coach will receive a copy of how the other coaches voted. The voting will take place at the all-conference meeting, which will be held in Menomonie on the Monday following the last week of the regular season. Player of the Year honors will be a separate vote after the first team all conference team has been determined. Coaches of players on the first team will have the option to nominate one of their players (from the first team) for Player of the Year honors. All coaches will then vote for player of the year from the nominees brought forward. Coaches may not vote for their own player for player of the year honors.

## **Other Pertinent Information:**

Team rosters shall be provided to the host school and shall include: Players name – number – position – year in school along with names of coaches, managers, cheerleaders, mascot, school song and any information schools deem necessary and important by the sending school.
