

BIG RIVERS CONFERENCE TRACK AND FIELD BYLAWS

- Athletic Director in Charge:** Hudson
- Annual Meeting Date:** Track coaches will meet on the first Wednesday of December to address any issues with the By-Laws.
- Uniforms:** WIAA rules will govern uniforms.
- Equipment:** WIAA rules will govern equipment.
- Referees and Scoring:** Fully automatic timing will be used for JV and Varsity. Officials are to be hired by the Athletic Director of the host school for the Varsity and JV Conference meets. Three officials shall be preferred for the Varsity meet.
- Conference Meet:** At the Conference Scratch Meeting, each school shall be represented by a maximum of two coaches, one boys' coach and one girls' coach.
1. Format for the Conference Meet will be consistent with the WIAA Regional. (Exception: replacements will be allowed on the day of the meet. Exception 2: There will be no prelims of the 200m dash.) Break time between the prelims and finals shall be 30 minutes.
 2. Conference Meet will be on the Tuesday before WIAA Regional with scratch meeting at 3:00pm – field events starting at 3:30pm and running events at 4:15pm. Rain date is Wednesday of that same week. Site of the Conference Championship Meet will rotate.
 3. Conference entry forms are due on Sunday prior to the meet by 5:00pm. If entry is not received by that time, host school will proceed with seeding. It is recommended that entries be posted by Noon (12:00pm) on Monday prior to the meet.
 4. Jury of Appeals shall consist of the meet manager and one coach from the prior year host school and one coach from the school hosting the following year.
 5. The Conference treasury will pay for automated timing and awards.
 6. Host school shall send contact cell phone number of meet manager to all schools prior to the meet.

All-Conference Selection:

First place finisher in each event, including relays – Gold medal with BRC Logo on front – Back of medal should state, as an example – “2016 BRC High Jump Champion”

Second place finisher in each event, including relays – Silver medal with BRC Logo on front – Back of medal should state, as an example – “2016 BRC High Jump, 2nd place”

Third place finisher in each event, including relays – Bronze medal with BRC Logo on front – Back of medal should state, as an example – “2016 BRC High Jump, 3rd place”

BRC Most Valuable Field Athlete – Certificate made by the school of award winner

BRC Most Valuable Track Athlete – Certificate made by the school of award winner

Junior Varsity Conference:

JV Conference Meet will be on the Thursday before the WIAA Regional with coaches meeting at 3:00pm – field events starting at 3:30pm and running events starting at 4:00pm. If hosting school has lights they have the option to start later. Rain date will be Friday of that same week.

1. Athletes who compete in more than one event in the Varsity BRC Meet are not allowed to compete in the BRC JV Meet. Athletes may not compete in the same event in both meets.
2. There will be only one relay team per school (4x800, 4x400, 4x200, 4x100)
3. Three throws/three jumps per contestant, each contestant throws before they can hold and running events are finals only.
4. There is no limit on the number of entries not previously listed.
5. The starting heights in the boys' and girls' pole vault will be set at the discretion of the host school, who will notify all member schools in advance.

6. No team trophies or plaques are to be awarded. Ribbons will be awarded to the top three finishers in each event.
7. JV Meet entries are due the Tuesday prior to the Meet by Midnight (12:00am)
8. JV Conference Meet will be held at the next year's Varsity Conference site.
9. JV Conference is a non-scored Meet.
10. The Conference treasury will pay for automated timing and awards.

11. The host school shall send contact phone number of meet manager to all schools prior to the meet.
