

BIG RIVERS CONFERENCE GIRLS SOCCER BYLAWS

Athletic Director in Charge: Superior

Annual Meeting Date: Monday evening following the last conference game or BRC tournament.

Game Times: Varsity: 7:00 PM if school has lights. 5:00 with no lights
JV: 5:00 pm.

Warm Up Times: Set clock at 20 minutes. Five minutes before game, players to bench. National Anthem and introductions of starters for both teams.

Equipment: Game ball will be any NFHS approved ball. Uniform color will follow WIAA regulations

Conference Schedule: The teams will play a round robin schedule. At the conclusion of this round, the schools will be split into 2 groups (top 4 and bottom 5) based on record.

- * If there is a tie for the fourth place spot between two teams, the first tiebreaker will be head to head. If they played a tie game, it will be the first team that scored. If they played a 0-0 tie, it will be a coin toss.
- * If there is a tie for the fourth place spot between three teams, the first tiebreaker will be head to head. If still tied, it will be goal-differential. If still tied, a coin toss will be used.
- * The top four teams will play a round robin. Home locations for these top 4 games will be opposite of where the teams played their first round.
- * The bottom 5 teams will be guaranteed two games within the group. AD's will try to guarantee games will be opposite of where the teams played their first round.

Conference Championship: Conference champion will be the the team with the best record in the upper half of the four team round robin. If a three way tie, all three teams will share the championship.

All-Conference Selection: The coaches will nominate players from their team that they feel are worthy of being named all conference. The players that they nominate should be one of the top 22 players in the BRC. Procedure will be:

- * Coaches will use the nomination ballot provided by the AD in charge of soccer. Nominations are due back to the AD by the Tuesday of the last week of the regular season.
- * The AD in charge will provide a list of nominations along with the information form provided by each school to all coaches via fax or email by Thursday of the last week of the regular season. The nomination list will have all the nominated athletes listed by name and school only.
- * When voting, each coach will vote for the players they feel deserve to be named to the first team by using numbers 1-10 (#1 as their top choice) for the field players and #1 for their choice of first team goalkeeper.
- * For the second team coaches will use numbers 11-20 (#11 as the top second team player) and #2 for the second team goalkeeper.
- * A #1 ranking shall equal 20 points, #2 ranking shall equal 19 points, #3 ranking shall equal 18 points etc. down to #20 ranking equals 1 point.
- * Coaches may not vote for players from their own team.
- * The top 10 field players and top goalkeeper with votes will receive 1st team recognition. The field players with the 11th through 20th and second highest goalkeeper will receive 2nd team recognition. The next 11 players, regardless of position that receive the highest number of votes will be named to the honorable mention team.
- * Each coach will receive a copy of how the other coaches voted.

Coaches of players on the first team will have the option to nominate one of their players (from the first team) for Player of the Year honors. All coaches will then vote for player of the year from the nominees brought forward. Coaches may not vote for their own player for Player of the Year honors.

Other Pertinent Information: Team rosters shall be provided to the host school and shall include: Players name - number - position - year in school along with names of coaches, managers, cheerleaders, mascot, school song and any information schools deem necessary and important by the sending school.

Media/Requests: The host school shall be responsible for reporting the results to the media and the BRC statistician following the game
