

## BIG RIVERS CONFERENCE SOFTBALL BYLAWS

Athletic Director in Charge: Eau Claire Memorial

Annual Meeting Date: Wednesday between Regional Division 1 games at 7:00 pm in Eau Claire, site to be determined

Game Times: Varsity: Single Games - 4:30 in April, 5:00 in May. Doubleheader makeup games - 4:00  
JV: Same location and times as varsity;  
3rd Level: Will be negotiated between schools if both have three levels

Warm Up Times: A minimum of 30 minutes warm-up before the scheduled game at all levels. HOME school will start warm-ups ½ hour prior to start time.

Equipment: Three new Dudley SB 121/non poly core game balls per game provided by home team.

Season Schedule: Games will be played on Tuesdays and Thursdays. These will be home and home series between the same teams. If the game is canceled on Tuesday, it will be made up as a doubleheader on Thursday at the school that was scheduled to host on Thursday. If game(s) are canceled on Thursday, they will be played at that location on Friday. Teams are encouraged to either leave Fridays open or be prepared to cancel their game on Friday to play the conference game. Furthermore, it is recommended that teams that host on Thursday, also host non-conference on Friday. If this case they will already have umpires hired in case the Thursday game(s) have to be played on Friday.

For the doubleheaders, the home team for the first game will be the school that was supposed to host the Tuesday game. Game two home team will be the school hosting the DH.

Conference Championship: Will be determined by winning percentage. In case of a tie, multiple champions will be recognized.

All-Conference Selection: The selection of players to be recognized by the conference will take place at the annual meeting. Each team may nominate players for first, second, and honorable mention team. Eleven players will be selected to the First Team All Conference and each player will receive a medal. Eleven more players will be selected as to the Second Team All Conference and each player will receive a certificate. Any player receiving a vote for an all-conference team, but does not receive enough to make the first or second team will earn honorable mention. On vote will occur when voting for all-conference. Coaches will rank the top 22 players from 22 down to 1. The top eleven players receiving total votes will be first team, and the second eleven total votes will be elected to the second team. In the event there is a tie at number 11 and 22, a revote for that specific spot will occur.

Media/Results: Coaches will provide the BRC Statistician with the statistics below after every game. These stats will be shared according to coaches agreement during the season and for the all-conference meeting. Stats will include.
